THE LOST CITY

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The panel descriptions and the number of panels on each page present a basic structure for the story. If you wish to tweak them a bit, go for it. You are the visual artist, after all. I would, however, like to preserve the flow of the individual pages, the story beats on them, and what happens before and after a page turn.

PANEL 1

EXTERIOR, BIG PANEL. We are in an overgrown jungle. We see nothing but vegetation with big trees mostly blocking out the sun. There are two people trying to get through the jungle: a MAN and a WOMAN. The man is in <u>front</u>, clearing the way with his big machete. The woman is <u>behind him</u> with a bow and a quiver on her back. They are both dressed in plain clothing that can't really be placed in a specific period, suggesting that this story could take place in the present as well as 100 years ago.

If you'd like, you can code the man as an Indiana Jones type and the woman as a Lara Croft type, but preferably don't make it too on the nose.

MAN

It's getting harder and harder to get through this terrain.

Nobody's been here for years.

Maybe ever.

WOMAN Which means we're going in the right direction.

PANEL 2

SMALL PANEL, a close-up of the MAN's machete cutting through the jungle.

PANEL 3

SMALL PANEL, a close-up of the WOMAN's boot stepping on some leaves and twigs. We can maybe also see a small bug on the ground.

PAGE TURN

PAGE 2 - PANELS: 4

PANEL 1

Here we can again see BOTH CHARACTERS.

MAN Do you really think it's here? **The Lost City?** WOMAN I do. The world still is a mystery. Even if we try to convince ourselves otherwise. There is plenty of places to explore...

PANEL 2

Bigger focus on both characters, the MAN in the <u>front</u>, staring at something ahead off-panel, and the WOMAN in the <u>back</u>, not noticing it yet.

WOMAN ...plenty of time periods. MAN Yeah... I think you might be right.

PANEL 3

We see BOTH CHARACTERS from the back, getting out of the thick dark jungle. There is a source of light ahead. An exit.

PANEL 4

BIG PANEL. We are out of the jungle, the thick part of it anyway. The sun is shining. We again see BOTH CHARACTERS from the back. They are small, dwarfed by what is standing in front of them. By what they are looking at.

We see two massive seemingly stone blocks, as big as skyscrapers. We can only presume they are made from stone because they are all covered in vegetation. They look like two massive monoliths with a path between them, seemingly forming like a gate of sorts.

WOMAN

Wow...

I knew it.

MAN

I guess you did.

PAGE 3 - PANELS: 5

Like I said.

PANEL 1

The MAN and the WOMAN are now getting closer to the two monoliths. MAN These must be **ancient**. Hundreds of years. Maybe **thousands**. But who built them? And how?

PANEL 2

BOTH CHARACTERS are now even closer to the monoliths.

WOMAN

We don't know as much about this world as we think we do.

I bet structures like these could be spread all around the globe.

We just need to start looking **hard** enough.

PANEL 3

BOTH CHARACTERS are now walking between the two monoliths. The distance from one to the other could be about 15 to 20 meters. We can also see that, as the path goes forward, other monoliths (with some spaces between them) just follow it as far as the eye can see.

MAN This is just...

...impossible.

Maybe they didn't.

I don't think people could have built this.

WOMAN

PANEL 4

We now see some rubble on the path between the monoliths, although we can again only speculate that it is rubble because of the overgrown vegetation.

WOMAN	Mavbe.
MAN	Or maybe this planet had visitors.
	species that has evolved on this planet.
WOMAN	Maybe we are not the first intelligent

PANEL 5

The MAN is cutting through the vegetation with his machete, while the WOMAN is getting her bow and arrow ready.

MAN Watch out for animals. I really don't like it here. WOMAN Right there with you.

PAGE 4 - PANELS: 3

PANEL 1

SMALL PANEL, focused on the rubble, now being set free of the vegetation by the MAN's hands and machete.

WOMAN (OP) But what if we meet something **other** than animals here? I don't think so.

PANEL 2

We again see BOTH CHARACTERS. With the WOMAN keeping watch and the MAN revealing what seems to be some sort of a tablet from underneath the vegetation.

MAN

Whoever lived here, whoever built this, is long gone. As powerful as these beings must have been to create all of this...

PANEL 3

BIG PANEL. BOTH CHARACTERS are now inspecting the "rubble" the man discovered under the vegetation. It is a big sign. A sign of... whatever you like. Maybe a sign for a McDonald's restaurant, a piece of an ad billboard, or something else... The point here is that this ancient civilization is us. The monoliths truly are skyscrapers and the path between them is a metropolitan street. We are in a distant, distant future.

MAN

...I guess time comes for us all.
